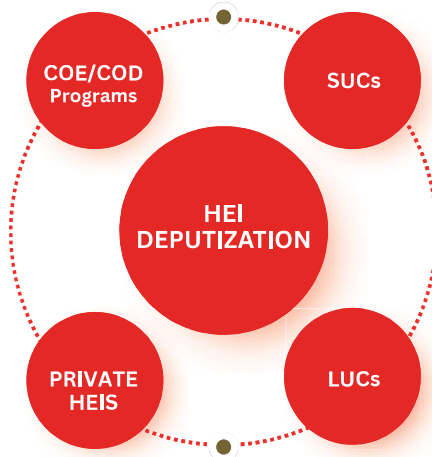


## WHAT IS ETEEAP?

- ✓ **ETEEAP** is a flexible alternative pathway to a college degree that recognizes and accredits learning gained from:
  - ▶ Work experience
  - ▶ Non-formal and informal training
  - ▶ Life experiences and prior learning
  
- ✓ Institutionalized under **Republic Act No. 12124**, ETEEAP promotes:
  - ▶ Inclusive and accessible higher education
  - ▶ Recognition of learning outside formal schooling
  - ▶ Flexible entry and lifelong learning pathways
  - ▶ Alignment with national development and workforce needs

## ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR DEPUTIZATION

Public and private Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) may be deputized upon meeting any of the following:



- ✓ Recognized as a Center of Excellence (COE) or Center of Development (COD) in the program/discipline to be offered.
- ✓ For SUCs, at least Level II accreditation status in the appropriate program/s to be offered through ETEEAP, with a corresponding Certificate of Program Compliance (COPC).
- ✓ For LUCs, must have equivalent Institutional Recognition (IR) and a Certificate of Program Compliance (COPC) for the program/s to be offered.
- ✓ For Private HEIs, must have Autonomous or Deregulated Status.

## KEY NOTES

- ✓ HEIs must have complete systems for assessment, quality assurance, and learner support
- ✓ Deputization is **valid for five (5) years**, subject to renewal and evaluation
- ✓ Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) with pending legal cases, complaints, and/or issued Show Cause Orders may submit their application only after these matters have been resolved.

## WHO MAY APPLY?

### ETEEAP LEARNER QUALIFICATIONS



Filipino citizen (local or overseas)



At least 23 years old



Completed secondary education (High School, ALS, or PEPT passer), or a college undergraduate/Tech-Voc graduate



With minimum five (5) years of relevant work experience related to the degree being pursued

### BASIC DOCUMENTARY REQUIREMENTS

- PSA Birth Certificate
- Secondary education credential or Official Transcript of Records (OTR)
- Comprehensive work portfolio
- Certificates of relevant training programs / TESDA National Certificates (NCs), if applicable
- Employer or industry recommendation
- Other documents as may be required by the deputized HEI
